


## Making Custom Clone Stamp Brushes

- 1. Click the Clone Stamp
- 2. In the CLONE Dialog Box below click the BRUSH image.



- 3. Click the **PAINT BRUSH** in the lower right Corner.
- 4. Click on the **NEW** button on the bottom of the window






- 5. In the Brush editor, make a new Brushe by filling in the boxes as described below:
  - Brush 1 Replace the "UNTITLED" words with: Title "30 Soft"

Radius TYPE "30"

Hardness TYPE "0.5"

## 6. To SAVE

Click the K to close the box
